Shipping to Canada

Things to Note:

- We cross the US/Canada Border at 3 locations every business day.
- For faster transit, we electronically transmit customs documentation before the shipment arrives at the Canadian point of entry.
- If paperwork listed below is not presented at the border, the shipment will be delayed.

Paperwork Required from Shipper:

- Bill of Lading (BOL)
- Canada Customs Invoice or Commercial Invoice (must have the following info)
 - Mark the name of the Canadian Customs Broker anywhere on the BOL
 - Shipper, Consignee Name & address
 - Importer (If it's not the same as the Consignee)
 - Pieces & weight
 - o Full Description of goods
 - Invoice amounts (unit price & total)
 - Currency of Settlement (US or Canadian funds)
 - Country of Origin (where the individual products are made)

(Shipper's responsibility to complete customs documents)

- Certificate of Origin or USMCA Certificate (if required).
 - This form may already be on file with your customs broker. A blank certificate is available on our website's Forms page.
